



Where to Get Your 2nd Dose Pfizer BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine

You have received your first dose of the two-dose Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine. You should get your second shot 3 weeks (or 21 days) after your first. The CDC recommends you get your second shot as close to the recommended 3-week interval as possible. However, your second dose may be given up to 6 weeks (42 days) after the first dose, if necessary. You should not get the second dose early. There is currently limited information on the effectiveness of receiving your second shot earlier than recommended or later than 6 weeks after the first shot.

The Lancaster County Community Vaccination Center will be permanently closing June 30 and will not be your vaccination site for your second dose. We are pleased to have partnered with Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health, Penn State Health, UPMC and WellSpan Health to offer you a variety of options for getting your second dose. Please see below for details.

Vaccines are available by appointment at these dedicated Penn State Health vaccination sites:

- Berks County (2400 Bernville Road, Reading): Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays.
- Dauphin County (30 E. Granada Ave. #200, Hershey): Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

Walk-in vaccinations are not available at these locations.

UPMC

Schedule your Pfizer 2nd dose appointment by calling 833-664-1969 between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Appointments will be available at UPMC Lititz, 1500 Highlands Drive, Lititz, from 3 to 5 p.m. on the following Thursdays: July 8, 15, 22 and 29. Appointments are also available at clinics in York, Dauphin and Cumberland counties. UPMC does not currently offer walk-in vaccinations.

WellSpan Health

Call the WellSpan vaccination hotline at 855-851-3641 to schedule your Pfizer 2nd Dose appointment. The hotline is staffed Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Saturday from 9 a.m. to noon. WellSpan also offers walk-in vaccinations (Pfizer vaccine only) from noon to 3 p.m. on the specified days at these locations:

- **WellSpan Ephrata Community Hospital** – 169 Martin Ave., Ephrata (Monday, Wednesday & Friday)
- **WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital** – 252 S. 4th St., Lebanon. (Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday)
